#### The School Picnic

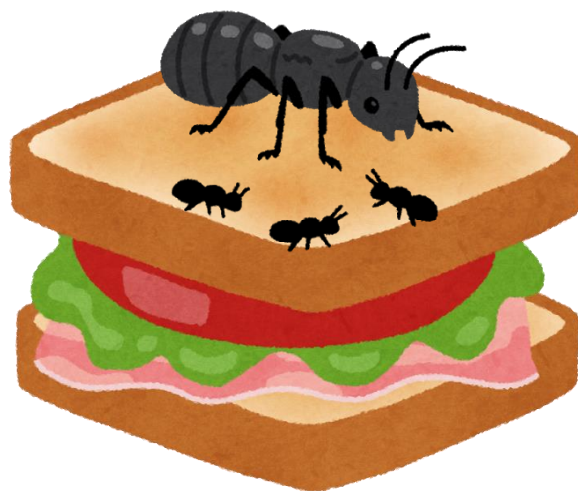

#### The School Picnic

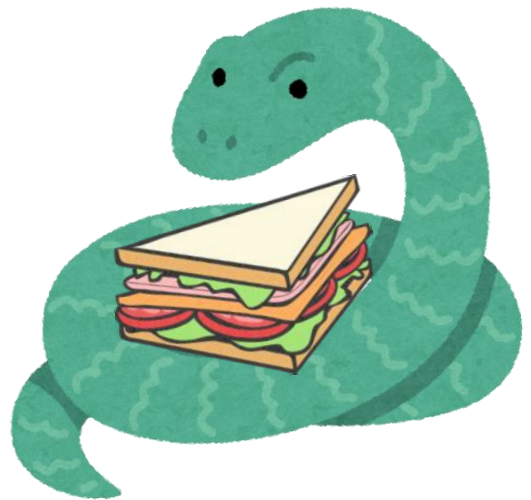

### In the Toy Shop

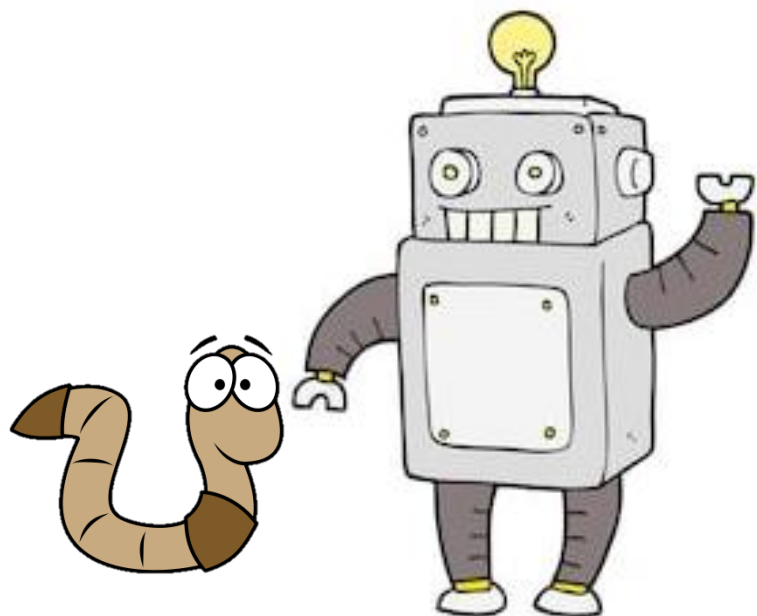
David and his mum go to Fun Fun Toy Shop to buy some toys. He looks at the robots because there is a big sale on the toys. He feels happy.

#### David's Lucky Day

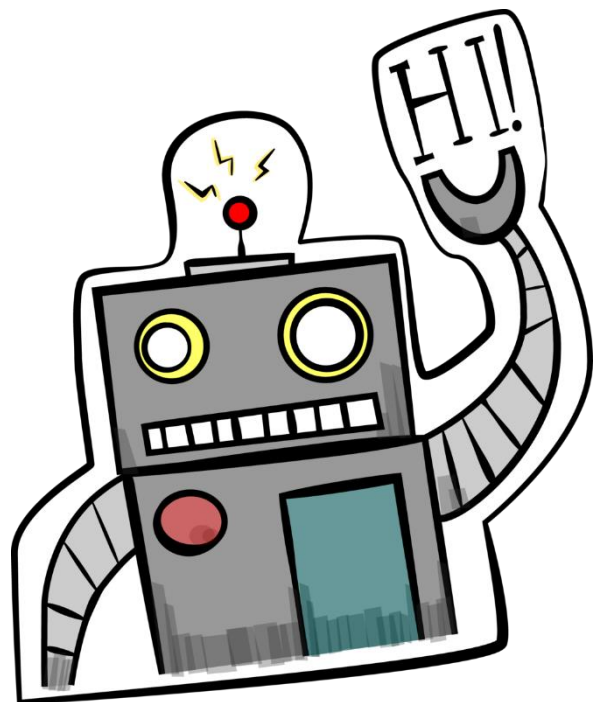
David and his mum go to Fun Fun Toy Shop to buy a toy. He looks at some robots. They are on the shelves. He feels excited.

### At the Toy Shop

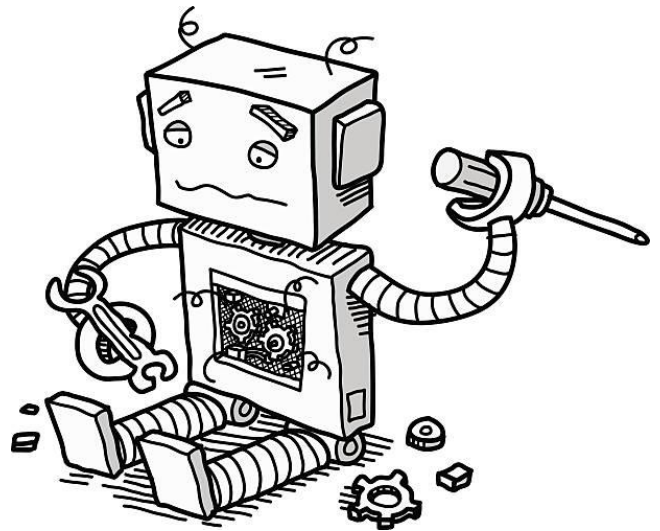
David and his mum go to Fun Fun Toy Shop to buy toys because today is David's birthday. He looks at the robots. He feels so excited because he can buy some toys.

### My Dream School

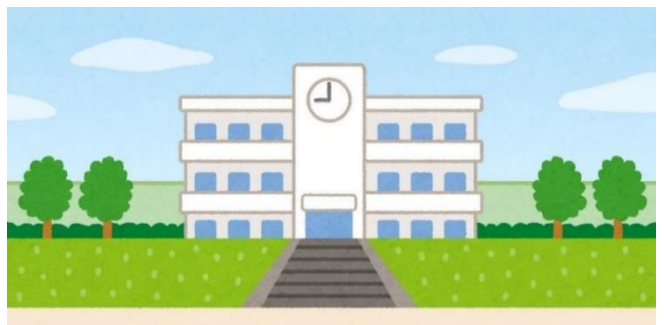
My dream school has a lot of facilities and it is spacious. It has a gym room, a table tennis room and a big swimming pool so that all students can do sports every day and stay healthy.

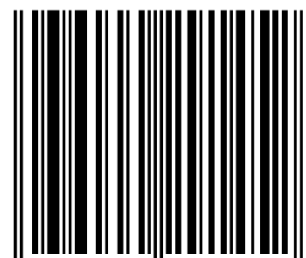
