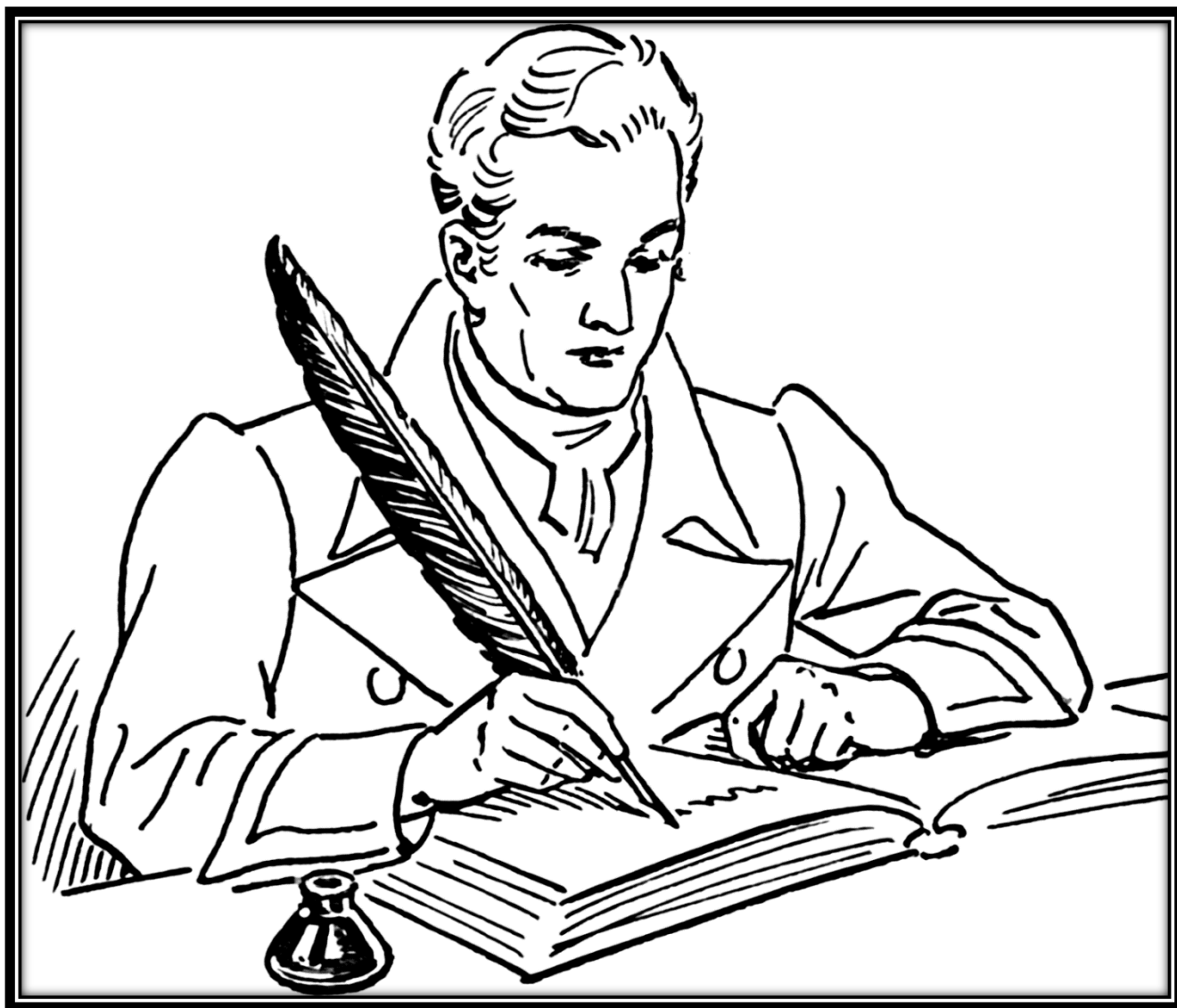

I can see chairs and tables.

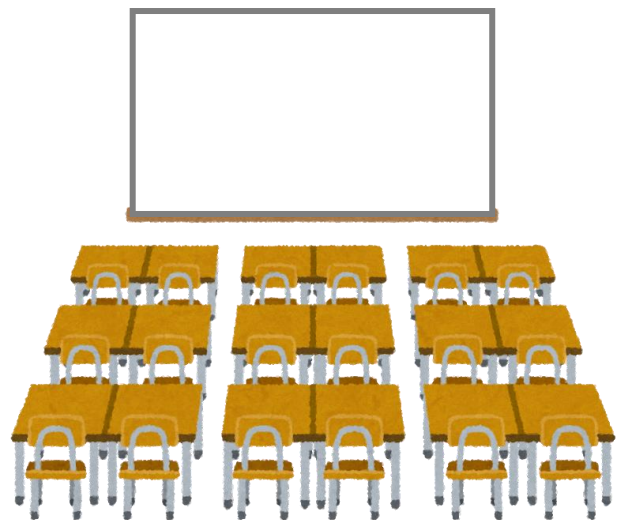
I can hear children shouting and talking.

3B Angie A Visit to Happy Farm

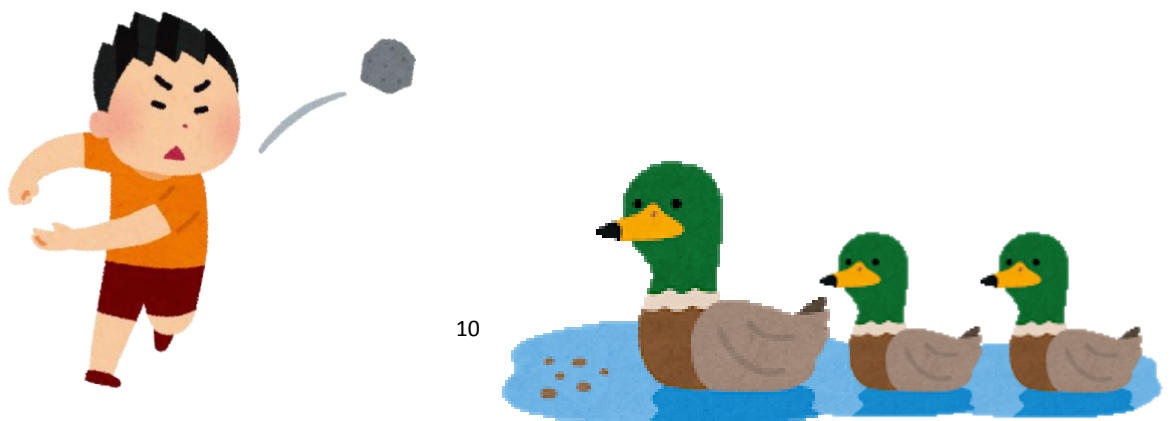

I will not give up and I hope I will achieve great results.

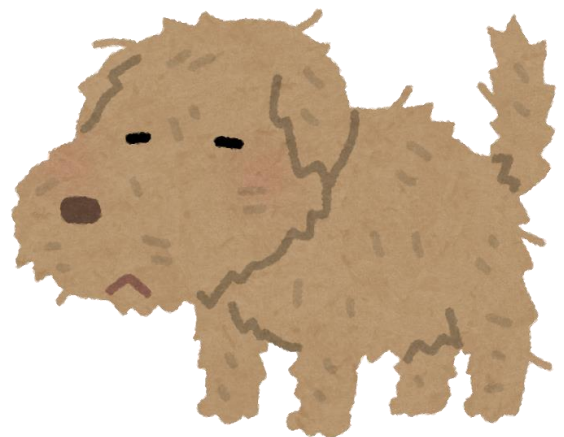


5A Hillary A Stray Dog

5B Michaela The Birthday Gift

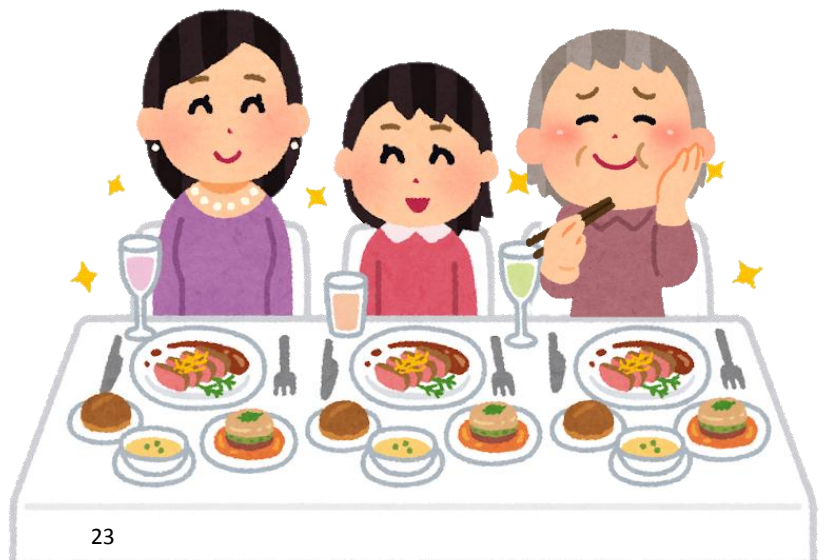
It will be Grandma's birthday tomorrow. Mum and I wanted to make a cake for the party tonight.

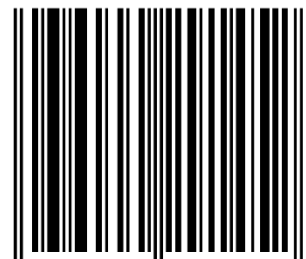
