In the evening, I have a bath at six o'clock. I have dinner at seven o'clock. I play computer games at half past seven. I go to bed at nine o'clock.



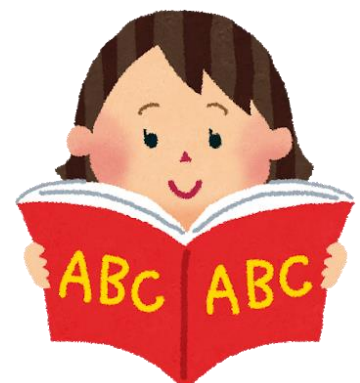

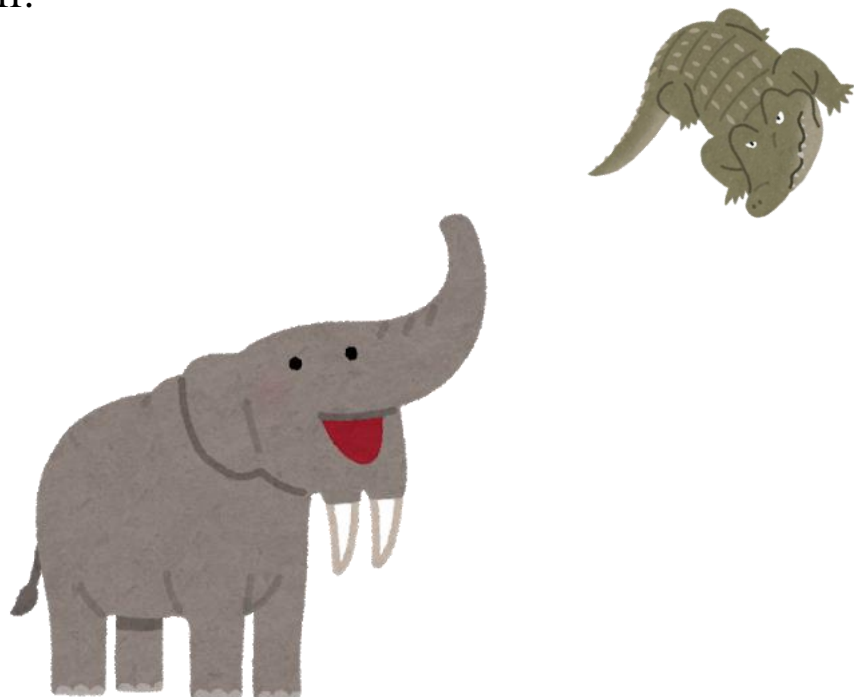
Book Review of the Enormous Crocodile

If I become a film director, I will direct a lot of interesting films. I will join some competitions and win awards. I will be rich too. If I become rich, I will buy new clothes.

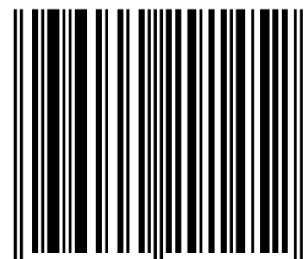
