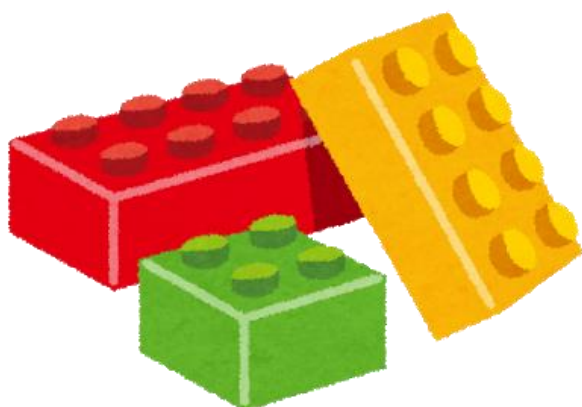
My Best Friend

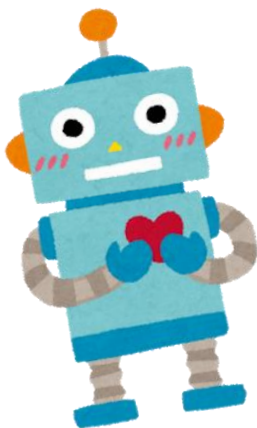
Buying Toys

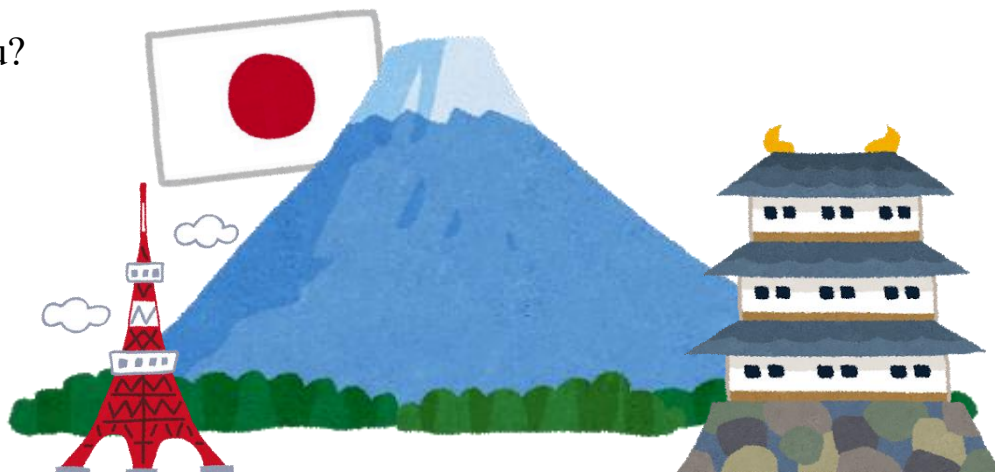
Japan is famous for its food such as sushi, tempura and ramen noodles. They are mouthwatering. If you want to eat more healthily, you can choose green tea.

Do you know which country is my favourite? That's right! It is the USA.

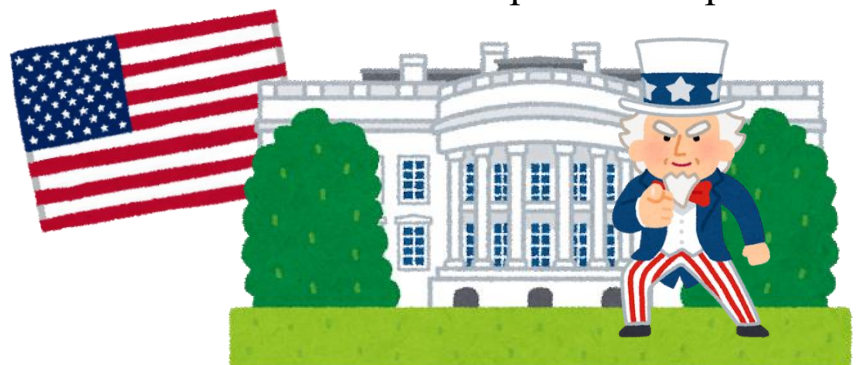

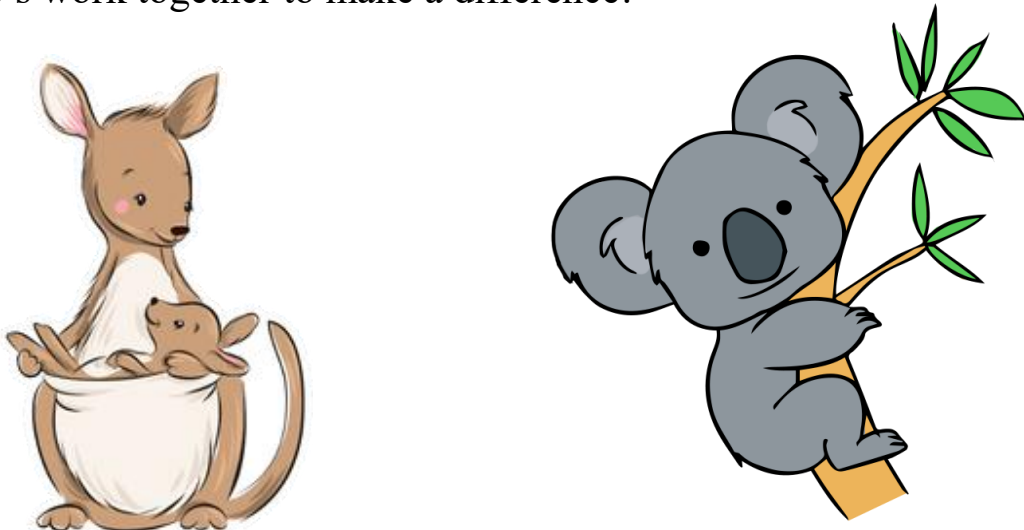
Help the Animals in Australia

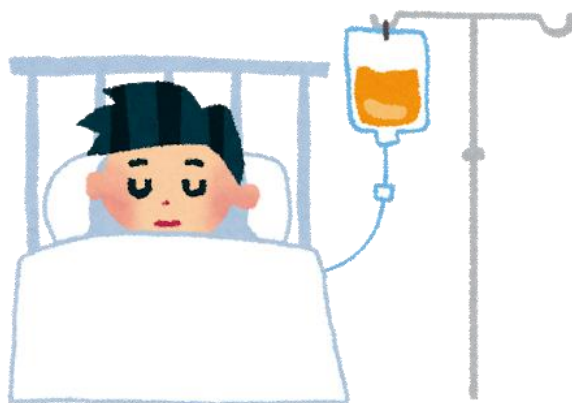
Next, we taught them how to make puppets. We use old gloves to make some lovely puppets. Everyone was glad but a boy with glasses looked upset.

‘Zootropolis’ is about a rabbit, Judy, who wants to be a police officer. She meets Nick the fox when she investigates a case and a lot of things happen.

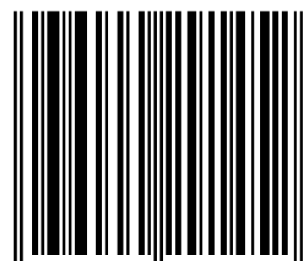
